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JUDGEMENT ENTRY

The Defendant having applied to the Court for sealing of the criminal record, and upon the evidence and arguments presented, finds as follows:

1. The applicant is an eligible offender.
2. No criminal proceedings are pending against the applicant.
3. The applicant has been rehabilitated to the satisfaction of this Court.
4. It is in the best interests of the applicant to have the record sealed and there is no legitimate need for the government to maintain these records.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED**, that all official records pertaining to this case be sealed and all index references thereto shall be deleted, except as otherwise provided in ORC 2953.32, that the proceedings of said case shall be deemed not to have occurred, and that the Defendant's conviction/dismissal shall be sealed, subject to the exceptions set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 2953.32.

It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that no officer or employee of the State or any political subdivision thereof, except as authorized by Division (D) and (E) of Section 2953.32 of the Revised Code, shall release, disseminate, or make available for any purpose involving employment, bonding, or licensing in connection with any business, trade, or profession to any person, department, agency, or other instrumentality of the State's Government or any political subdivision thereof, any

information or date concerning any arrest, indictment, trial hearing, conviction, or correctional supervision.
